BIBLE READING and TALK: Ephesians 2:11-22

Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called 'uncircumcised' by those who call themselves 'the circumcision' (which is done in the body by human hands) - ¹² remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel
